



Dr Celia Ravel, Rennes University, France

Dr Celia Ravel is professor of histology and embryology at Rennes University. Her current position also include the Laboratory of Biology of Reproduction of Rennes Hospital and INSERM-IRSET researcher. She received her M.D. at University Pierre et Marie Curie in Paris and her Ph.D. at the Institut Pasteur in Paris. Ravel's laboratory is centered around a 'bedside-to-bench' approach to translational research. This has helped her to stay firmly rooted in clinically relevant scientific questions, which has furthered the understanding of gonadal pathogenesis and human infertility. She is member of the board of directors of the French Federation of CECOS (Centers for the Study and Conservation of Human Eggs and Sperm) and coordinator of the biobank GERMETHEQUE dedicated to human fertility research. Pr Ravel has published more than one hundred original articles in peer-reviewed journals.
